Footnotes

NOTASHYVIOLET, bumped at the start and forced into the path of SANS MERCI, recovered quickly to force the pace three deep into the turn, dueled with CENTER POINT BLAZE into the lane, then edged clear of that rival in late stages under steady left handed encouragement. The latter was hustled to the front along the rail, dueled gamely inside the winner into the stretch, then weakened leaving the furlong pole. GRAMDANYA, allowed to settle soon after the break, steadied a bit when in tight on the backstretch, angled five wide on the turn to challenge, continued in that path through the lane but could not menace the top two. BITTERROOT PRIDE vied six wide to the turn, couldn't match terms with the leaders and faded approaching the quarter pole. CALHERSHAMELESS, outpaced early, split foes on the bend and passed tiring rivals late. POSEIDONS TREASURE broke inwards, bumping A IS FOR AMBERLY, tracked the leaders along the inside but could offer nothing further after a half. RAISE A BROW broke inwards bumping the winner, chased the pace five wide for a quarter, angled in on the turn and quickly gave way. A IS FOR AMBERLY, bumped at the start, was soon outpaced and never threatened thereafter. PINECREEK ROSE, brushed early by SANS MERCI, never gained contention. SANS MERCI was brushed at the break by the winner, was collected to briefly prompt the pace between rivals, but gave way readily midway through the turn. ITLLBEACOLDDAY, caught seven wide in the second flight, soon faded.
