Footnotes

CARNIVAL CANDYMAN stalked the pace on the outside, moved up to bid just outside that one, drifted out and drew off. DEAL OF A LIFETIME sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start while pulling, could not go with the winner the final furlong, stayed on to be clearly best of the rest. MISCHIEF MO well back, moved up on the two path through the second turn, bid between rivals into the stretch and evened out. CATHYS BREEZE mid pack and inside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, fanned four wide to bid and lacked the needed kick. TOO BOLD TO HOLD improved his position. DEAN DOESN'T KNOW well placed and three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, drifted in and weakened. IN FOR A SONG ran evenly. MAGICAL STORM stumbled at the start and was no factor. CHISENAU tracked the pace inside and stopped.
