Footnotes

SIPPIN' DEVIL went up to join the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, forged clear on the backstretch, repelled several foes racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under strong handling. MISS CREE tracked the leaders in second flight to the backstretch, made a steady advance on the leader nearing the far turn, proved no match for that foe but was clearly second best. CEEHAWK, allowed to settle in early stages, came around foes racing into upper stretch and improved her position while never gaining terms with the top pair. NATURE COAST tracked the pace between foes, made a three deep bid on the far turn and flattened out. SPELLFIRE was angled to the inside, tracked the leaders to the backstretch, then faded steadily from contention on the far turn. DYNAMIC WONDER tracked the leaders along the inside but never gained striking position. SENTIMENTL DINNER never seriously menaced. MARY'S SPECIAL showed little. DIAMONDSAREFOREVER flashed brief pace along the inside but gave way abruptly after a half.
