Footnotes

LIL MAKENA raced unhurried outside foes in the opening quarter, made a steady advance to contention three deep on the turn, drew on terms with the pacesetter in upper stretch, took over and held LORD'S VIEW safe under firm encouragement. The latter tracked just off the second flight racing to the bend, angled out four wide on the turn, then continued in that path through the stretch while gaining well late. TREMENDO shifted inwards after the start, saved ground on the bend and improved his position to the final stages. SAINTLY SON exchanged bumps with SECRET YANKEE at the start, tracked the pace off the inside and made some belated progress racing into the lane. DINNER MAGIC went readily to the fore, held sway to upper stretch but faltered once headed by the winner. CLASSIC TANAGER angled inwards chasing the pacesetter to the turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. TOOL TRADE, close up along the inside early, faded steadily from contention after three furlongs. DIXIE LUC POWER exchanged bumps with SAINTLY SON at the start and never menaced thereafter. SECRET YANKEE, bumped, then shuffled back at the start, trailed throughout.
