Footnotes

ASHURST sprinted clear of his rivals into the first turn, dictated the tempo under light rating to the far turn, then held sway to the end under steady pressure. HOPETOWN HERO, forwardly placed outside foes racing to the backstretch, stalked just off the pacesetter to the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner but gamely prevailed for the place. SHEBA'S CHARM, unhurried saving ground in early stages racing as part of the second flight, advanced along the rail on the far turn to gain striking distance, couldn't sustain that effort through the final eighth and lost the place late. JACKSON ON TOUR was settled along the inside early, then continued in that path while making an effort to improve his position racing into the stretch. COOKSON, outpaced early, passed some tiring rivals in the final stages. CEDARWOOD, never far back in the opening half, made a brief bid three deep entering the far turn, but steadily faded after five furlongs. STAR KIMBERLITE tracked the pace between foes in second flight and emptied out after a half.
