GREEN SECRET rated nicely on a long lead, drew off when asked through the lane and was kept to the task. SARAHS SON rated back in the early going, angled out to bid widest into the stretch, then closed fast and got up for the place in the final strides while no threat to the winner. BRAHMS GIFT chased the winner on the rail, came through inside of rivals in the stretch, closed willingly and missed the place in the final strides. SHOOT IT'S WAR stalked the pace off the rail, appeared hard to rate, moved up to bid just outside the winner, then weakened late. RATE OF CHANGE stalked the pace inside, pulled to contention when clear, moved up three wide through the second turn and bid on that path into the stretch, then flattened out. ALERIC ran evenly. WALLY'S CHOICE was no factor.
