BERTS QUESTFORFAME sprinted clear of the field from the break, opened a commanding margin on the turn and held sway to the end under steady pressure. PERFECT BULL tracked the pacesetter racing three wide in second flight, continued in that path to upper stretch, then closed the gap on the winner late while always second best. CHASEN TATE was allowed to settle, saved ground while gathering momentum, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes and made some belated progress in the drive. FRIENDLY FORCE chased the pacesetter along the inside to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. POWER PAWS was a bit slow into stride, swung out racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position. I SIR FRISK ME NOW chased the pacesetter from between foes to the bend but emptied out nearing upper stretch. HARDTAX, unhurried outside foes in the opening stages, was caught four wide racing through the bend and offered no rally. SEARSPIONEER tracked the pace outside foes in second flight in the opening quarter but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. JULIAN G BROWN dropped out early. THE QUINNSTER trailed.
