Footnotes

TOURING AROUND raced unhurried outside foes as part of the second flight in the opening quarter, advanced on the leaders four deep nearing upper stretch, drew on terms with LILSTARSHINES leaving the furlong marker and edged that rival under firm encouragement. The latter, allowed to settle along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground on the bend while steadily advancing to contention, shifted outside a tiring rival in upper stretch to bid between foes, gained the lead between calls late but couldn't fend off the winner. MISTY TRICK went up to prompt the pace three wide racing into the bend, dueled in that path to upper stretch but weakened late when proving no match for the top pair. HARD TO CALL tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but came up empty in the drive. SAVANNAH ROSE was a bit outpaced early, shifted outside foes after the opening furlong and came around some tiring rivals in late stages. RACHELE R'S QUEEN was urged to join the pace along the inside from the outset, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. SPARKLING ENDEAVOR was hustled to contention between foes in the opening quarter but dropped out after a half.
