Footnotes

ART DECO LADY took up a tracking position while in hand as part of the second flight racing through the backstretch, readily advanced on the dueling leaders three wide leaving the turn, wrested command from those foes in mid stretch, then just held the late challenge of CLASSY CON under firm handling. CLASSY CON was allowed to settle along the inside in the opening stages, swung outside foes while rallying to contention leaving the turn and finished well to close the gap. CATRINA ERINA tracked the pace between foes to the lane, switched outside some tiring foes in the drive while making a mild gain but was outfinished by the top pair. LAKE HARRIET tracked the pace racing four wide to the turn, continued on that path through the bend but lacked a closing response. DEAL ME THE MOON angled inwards just after the start, dueled for command to the stretch and weakened in late stages. GO BABY GO GO tracked the leaders in second flight, saved ground through the turn but steadily faded in the drive. TOWICE NICE was hustled up to join the pacesetter, dueled inside that foe along the rail into the stretch and emptied out late.
