SUGAR STORM well placed and outside, moved up three wide through the turn, took command into the stretch, then drew off in the lane while being kept to the task. LITTLEBROWNROAD allowed to settle, moved up on the two path through the turn, came three wide to bid, then made a steady gain in the lane to get up for the place, could not threaten the winner while clearly best of the rest. MACK'S MONARCH awkward from the gate, was void of speed, moved up through the turn, then closed fast in the lane to get up for the show while no threat to the top two. FLAMING GLORY passed tiring rivals. TIMETOBOOK stalked the early pace on the inside, collard the leader through the turn, could not go with the winner into the stretch, stayed on and weakened the final furlong. BROKEANDBUSTED had a wide trip. MADDIE CAT set the early pace on the outside and stopped.
