GHAZMOSIS sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, was never challenged, drew off in the lane under steady pressure. TAHKODHA BUMP mid pack and outside, looped rivals four wide through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch and got up for the place while no threat to the winner. HALL OF JUSTICE well placed and outside, gained position through the turn, came three wide to bid and weakened the final sixteenth. JACK WINTER well back, moved up three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then drifted in through the lane while gaining. AWMA'S DIAMONDS mid pack, moved up three wide through the turn, came four wide to bid and lacked the needed late kick. R J TRUMPS THE SYN well placed and inside, dropped back through the turn, came again inside and weakened the final furlong. DEMIDOFFS PROSPECT ran evenly. EMPEROR'S CHOICE improved his position. GHAZI'S PATCH WORK chased the pace inside and was through after a half. STILLWATER JACK was no factor. SAMMY RAY was outrun.
