Footnotes

SPARKLING ENDEAVOR joined the pace outside a rival while angling inwards a bit in the opening furlong, dueled for command into the bend, dispatched that foe in upper stretch, then turned back a challenge from HILL CITY MISS to prevail under stout pressure. The latter tracked the leaders between foes in second flight, made steady progress to challenge three wide leaving the bend, gained a brief advantage nearing midstretch but proved second best. STRUTTINHERSTUFF bobbed at the break, was quickly righted, then hustled to the lead while angling to the rail, dueled for command into the turn and gave way in the drive. LILLY LADY was a bit outpaced early, angled out nearing the lane to split foes and continued to improve position. NIRVANI tracked the pace racing four wide into the turn and couldn't produce the needed closing bid. GOLD BREAK IN never seriously menaced. SHOTOFGO ducked inwards, hit the gate at the start and dropped out early. SWEET GOOSE tracked the pace between foes, angled out racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. POLISH FIRE chased the pace along the inside and faded after a half. CRESTED SHIELD was never a factor.
