### Footnotes

CORPORATE CHARLIE well placed and outside, looped rivals four wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, drifted in slightly under left hand urging, then drove clear late. BROKEN AERO well placed and inside, gained position through the second turn, was blocked into the stretch, got through between rivals, then altered out for clear racing room and could not match the winners stride late. BAD BOYZ HALO set the pace three wide, turned back a challenged through the second turn, shook clear into the stretch, then weakened the final furlong. SIX PACK ATTACK well back, moved up through the second turn, got through inside of rivals into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. PACKLEN'S BID ran evenly. BETTE'S AFTERSHOCK well placed and off the rail, came three wide to bid, steadied off a drifting rival into the stretch, then angled out for clear racing room and evened out. CLEARLYALUCKYGUY was no factor. MISTER WU was never involved. MAKING PAPA PROUD stalked the pace inside and stopped at the head of the lane. A CLAIM OF FOUL LODGED BY THE RIDER OF BROKEN AERO AGAINST THE WINNER WAS NOT ALLOWED.
