Footnotes

BAD BOY CHARLIE stalked the pace, moved up five wide into the lane and finished gamely to be clear under strong handling. BARCELONA KID pressed the pace while racing between horses and finished second best. SEEKING THE REWARD was unhurried early, angled out to the five path in the stretch and gained ground gamely to the wire. UNUSUAL MYSTERY was allowed to settle early, saved ground and showed good late interest. BROTHER DR. BOB was slow early, raced four wide and never was a factor. HOLIDAY FLIGHT was off slowly, rushed from the outside to press and tired. SUN'S OUT pressed the pace along the inside and tired. CHEAP CHOCOLATE failed to sustain a bid. BLOTHEHELD AWAY showed little.
