Footnotes

SUGAR DATE raced unhurried between foes in early stages tracking just behind the second flight, made steady progress on the second bend to gain striking position, split foes just off the inside nearing upper stretch to challenge inside the pacesetter, came through to gain a narrow advantage between calls late and just held SEENEMONNA T. V. safe under firm handling. The latter was allowed to settle while saving ground in the opening half, swung out four wide leaving the second turn while quickly drawing into striking position, drew on terms with the winner late but was outfinished. REGAL ROULETTE tracked the pacesetter between foes in second flight, advanced readily on the far turn to gain brief command, held a clear advantage in upper stretch but couldn't contain the top pair. TUSCANY BAY was a bit rank under reserve in the opening stages, swung out nearing the lane and made an effort to improve his position. NO. ONE SUSPECT stalked the pacesetter three deep in second flight racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid on the far turn but flattened out in the drive. TOKYO TOUR stalked the pacesetter along the rail as part of the second flight, but faded steadily from striking position on the far turn. OUR MOM RITA ROSE never seriously menaced. SARASWATIE was sent clear racing into the first bend, set the pace to the far turn and emptied out.
