GOODBYE MY LUV set the pace racing in hand for a half on the rail, drew clear of SINGING DIABLO on the far turn and maintained her advantage to the end under a steady drive. WELD tracked the leaders outside for a half, swung four wide on the far turn and proved no match. JAYSEEMA, under reserve early, made a belated rally between rivals into the stretch. LOOSE FOOTING, allowed to settle inside, made a belated effort outside. GLORIOUSLY, caught six wide early, made steady progress while racing wide into the stretch. COULEUR DE ROSE tracked the leaders between foes, menaced on the far turn and hung. SPATZAWAY, settled while angled in just after the start, had no rally. HEAVENLY JADE angled in sharply just after the break and passed tiring rivals into the stretch. TRAVELING STRANGER flashed brief pace between foes and gave way. SINGING DIABLO sprinted up into the first turn, bore out, recovered to contest the pace into the far turn and gave way. EXZOTTICA showed little.
