Footnotes

FRONTIER FRANNY took up a stalking position on the rail in the opening stages, raced just behind the leaders to the far turn, came out to split rivals in upper stretch, collared GAMBLERS PASSION leaving the sixteenth marker and just edged that rival under firm encouragement. The latter went up from the break to dictate the pace along the rail, turned back several foes leaving the far turn and grudgingly resisted the winner to the end. LEGENDARY SMILE was reserved racing to the backstretch, swung four wide racing into the lane and made some mild progress late. FARGO CALLING was held up outside foes in early stages, angled inwards on the far turn while briefly awaiting an opening from which to challenge but had no final kick. SHOOT FOR THE LOOT stalked just off the pacesetter in the opening half, pressed that foe on the far turn but emptied out in the drive. TURBULENT THINKING tracked the pace on the outside in second flight, made a brief, three wide bid on the far turn but flattened out in the lane. DYNABIN was allowed to settle along the inside early and never gained striking distance. GENTLE RACHEL was never a factor.
