WALTER broke inwards, was quickly righted to dispute the pace along the inside racing to upper stretch, edged forward of SHIKHAR leaving midstretch and held that foe under brisk right handed pressure. SHIKHAR broke inwards, was quickly collected to duel three wide between foes into the turn, continued well just outside the winner to late stages but proved second best. BISQUIK worked his way to the inside while readily gaining striking distance, switched out four deep in upper stretch, then closed the gap in late stages despite lugging in a bit. KEY ISSUES vied between foes for command from the outset, couldn't match the top pair after a half and weakened in upper stretch. GENERAL APPEAL, close up four wide early, faded after a half. G DANCE tracked the leaders along the inside but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. MANGETAKK tracked outside the first flight racing four or five deep to the turn, then dropped out nearing the lane. SUSYS' LIL LISTO never seriously menaced. QUICKIE O'BRIEN was outrun. GATO DE DIA was off slowly. GOLDEN AMIGO was off slowly and trailed throughout.
