DARK MARK sent from the gate, gained a clear lead while pulling soon after the start, drew off in the lane while being kept to the task. I NEED A BALEOUT chased the winner on the inside, angled out to bid just outside of that one, then closed willingly through the lane and was second best. BRASSY'S DELIGHT well placed and three wide, moved to a striking position through the turn, angled out slightly to bid four wide into the stretch, then could not gain in the late going. GRUBBS mid pack and inside, moved up on the rail to gain a share. OSCEOLA LIGHTNING well back and off the rail, fanned four wide to bid into the lane and improved his position. BOURBON BY THE BAY passed tiring rivals. SLEW CITY STORM was no factor, inside. SKIP THE CHAMPAGNE stalked the early pace outside and steadily faded.
