Footnotes

THE QUINSTER gained a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin through out, drew off in the lane and was kept to the task. DAWN RAIDER mid pack and inside, angled out slightly into the stretch, then made a steady gain to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. DANGEROUS SUMMER void of speed, moved up on the rail and gained a share. ROYAL SNEAKER stalked the early pace outside, drifted out in the stretch and weakened. FLEET CAVALRY well back and inside, moved to a striking position through the second turn, then had no rally. CHADDER well placed and off the rail, faded after a half. SELECTED well placed and three wide, faltered. CASSANOVA KID was never involved. CHASM (GB) drifted out badly through the second turn and was no factor.
