MR GOOD never far back and off the rail, moved up on the two path through the second turn, angled out to bid five wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drew off late. NORTHERN BUDDY rated back on the inside, gained a striking position inside through the second turn, got through inside of rivals at the quarter pole and lacked the needed late kick. CRAFTY SCORE stalked the early pace three wide, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then drifted in and weakened in the lane. MAGICAL STORM set the early pace inside, stayed on when challenged and weakened the final furlong. ITOUCH GOLD vied for the early lead outside, gained a short lead at the quarter pole, then faded in the lane. FAVRE N AWAY was a brief factor. WILLOW PARISH was never involved. DALLAS well placed and outside, gained a striking position through the second turn and had no rally.
