MESA MIRAGE set the pace inside, turned back and challenged through the second turn, drove clear and held under steady pressure. MORGANS A BLUMIN well back and inside, moved up through the second turn, then closed well through the lane to late. CAROUSING mid pack and on the rail, gained a striking position through the second turn, angled out into the stretch and ran evenly the final furlong. MY SWEET REVENGE stalked the early pace outside, challenged through the second turn, then lacked the needed late kick. JALAL well back and off the rail, moved up three wide through the second turn, then had no rally. UNDISTORTED tracked the pace on the inside, moved up on the two path through the second turn and ran evenly in the lane. A CLAIM OF FOUL LODGED BY THE RIDER OF UNDISTORTED AGAINST THE RIDER OF CAROUSING WAS NOT ALLOWED.
