STEAK HOUSE bucked at the start, was taken in hand to track the leaders from just out of striking position on the backstretch, steadily advanced on the first flight while still in hand racing through the bend, came out to challenge four deep in the lane, took charge under some hand prompting from his rider and pulled away to prevail easily. SUSYS' LIL LISTO, in close attendance to the early pace, advanced to press the pace three wide between foes on the turn, gained a narrow advantage in upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. GOOD MORNING PETE forced the pace four wide racing to the turn and proved no match for the top two in the drive. MAYWOOD'S QUICK veered in sharply bumping PICKSIX POWER at the start, was quickly righted to dispute the pace between foes racing to the bend, vied to upper stretch, then weakened in the last furlong. WILLY WOMPUS tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the turn but offered no closing bid. BECKEYS BENZ was hustled to the front, vied for command along the rail and gave way after a half. TEX TUMBLEWEED was a brief factor along the inside but faded steadily nearing the lane. ELVIS IMPRESSME was caught in tight quarters at the

start and never gained striking position. PICKSIX POWER, bumped soundly at the start, never menaced thereafter. OUR MAN SLEW, bumped by BOUND TO GO at the start, raced five wide to the turn and soon dropped out. LOCKSMITH OLAF showed little. BOUND TO GO broke inwards, bumped OUR MAN SLEW and quickly dropped out.
