Footnotes

HESO broke sharply, dictated the tempo racing just off the inside to upper stretch, turned back a challenge from HOT FOOT SLEW and edged clear late under firm right handed encouragement. The latter was urged to gain terms with the second flight on the rail in the opening quarter, came through inside the pacesetter to challenge nearing upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage but couldn't match the winner in the drive. BEST GAME IN TOWN was settled off and outside foes in the opening quarter, angled four wide nearing upper stretch while making some progress to gain contention, then continued evenly in the lane for a share. WALTER stalked just off and outside the pacesetter in the opening quarter, made a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but faded in the final quarter. VAZANDAR tracked just off the second flight racing along the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch but never gained striking distance. JOE FAVORITE was never a factor. CARSON BAY tracked the pacesetter racing three wide in second flight in the opening stages but gave way after a half.
