Footnotes

EL POPPIE sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin while never being challenged, then held through the lane under mild urging. GESUNDHEIT void of speed and inside, moved up inside, closed fast in the lane, split rivals late to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. MISTER MERZ well placed and outside, gained position through the second turn three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, then ran evenly the final furlong. ELLOREE TIGER well back and off the rail, moved up inside through the second turn, angled out to bid four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. UNBRIDLED FURY tracked the pace on the inside, then faded the final furlong. DALLIANCE well placed and inside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, then had no rally. CODE RUNNER was no factor.
