### Footnotes

MARCH TWELTH stalked the early pace three wide, bid just outside the pace setter, dueled through the lane and prevailed under brisk handling. JUST JEBICAH set the early pace inside, turned back a challenge through the turn, then dueled with the winner through the lane and weakened late. JOST VAN DYKE inside, angled out in the stretch for clear racing room and passed tiring rivals. DONT MAKE ME MAD vied for the early lead outside, couldn't go with JUST JEBICAH into the stretch, stayed on and weakened the final furlong. BOBADIEU tracked the early pace inside, gained a striking position through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and faded the final furlong. SHARKIOWA was no factor.
