Footnotes

WHO'S HUSSONET well back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, drifted in while gaining through the lane and drove clear late. A P DREAMER void of sped and inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, was blocked in the stretch, split rivals then could not threaten the winner while clearly best of the rest. VALISE tracked the pace on the rail, angled out to bid just outside the pace setter, then weakened the final furlong. THE QUINSTER set the pace on the inside and weakened in the stretch. SLEEK JOHN well placed and off the rail, gained a striking position through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and lost ground. PRETTY PRAIRIE well placed and outside, moved up to bid four wide, then ran evenly in the lane. SHRYOCK improved his position. SWEET FLEET FEET stalked the early pace outside, moved up to bid three wide, then had no rally. PLEASANT PROSPECT was no factor. BULLYA stalked the early pace three wide and was through after a half.
