FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE STARTED FOR A CLAIMING PRICE OF \$25,000 OR LESS SINCE JANUARY 1, 2008. WEIGHT: Three-year-olds, 117 lbs; Older, 124 lbs. Fillies and Mares allowed 5 lbs. With \$100,000 guaranteed of which \$55,000 to first, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth and \$1,000 to all other finishers. Non-winners of three races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$40,000 or greater since January 1, 2008 allowed 2 lbs; of two races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$32,000 or greater since January 1, 2008 allowed 4 lbs; of a race for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$32,000 or greater since January 1, 2008 allowed 6 lbs. Footnotes

GRAN ESTRENO (ARG) angled to the inside while gaining a forward placing racing to the first bend, led the second flight along the rail to the backstretch, shifted out three deep entering the far turn to gain terms with the leaders, bid for command in that path leaving the far turn, took over, then went clear in the last furlong under firm encouragement. HARD TOP (IRE) was settled for a half, swung out entering the far turn while making a sharp move to contention, circled five wide into upper stretch, shifted inwards while moving to challenge leaving the furlong marker bumping STORMY SURGE, continued lugging inwards to the end but held for the place. STORMY SURGE tracked the leaders racing three wide in the second flight, made a steady advance to contention

in that path entering upper stretch, steadied momentarily when bumped by HARD TOP (IRE), shifted out into the path of SPICY DUBAI but responded to sharp pressure and just missed the place. DRIVINGMAXANDMITZI angled inwards in the opening stages while reserved just out of striking distance early, made steady progress between foes into upper stretch, but lost his momentum when shuffled in traffic through the final furlong. SPICY DUBAI was reserved just off the inside to the backstretch, gathered momentum while being fanned seven wide into upper stretch and was bumped late. TRYING BRIAN angled inwards to join the pace outside a rival, dueled for command into upper stretch, couldn't sustain that effort in the last furlong and gave way. PURSUE A DREAM tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, was caught in tight quarters approaching midstretch and came up empty late. ALPHA CAPO shifted in sharply while gaining a forward placing, stalked just outside the eventual winner to the far turn while being carried four wide on the second bend, then lugged in through the last furlong when failing to maintain terms with that foe. T HARRY was settled along the inside to the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch while moving readily into striking position, was blocked, then steadied sharply approaching the furlong marker, angled out in the final stages but couldn't regain his momentum. GUN SALUTE worked his way to the inside tracking the leaders, was steadied in traffic through the final furlong and quickly lost contention. LUCKMAN was settled saving ground to the backstretch, continued to make steady progress nearest the rail to upper stretch, then was blocked and shuffled back in the final stages while losing his impetus. DIVINE MASTER sped to the lead from the break, dueled for command along the inside to the far turn, then gave way in upper stretch. SPIDER POWER (IRE) trailed.
