TULUPAI broke in bumping POWER ENOUGH at the start, readily joined the pace between foes racing through the backstretch, dueled outside a rival into the bend, then forged clear leaving mid stretch while being kept to the task. JO ME THE MONEY went up from the break to force the pace along the inside, disputed the issue to upper stretch but came up second best. TAYLOR'S A TRIP, pushed out a bit at the start by ARCH LADY, tracked the leaders in hand racing to the bend, angled inwards splitting foes on the turn and continued to improve position to the end. ARCH LADY broke out at the start, was angled to the rail while making some progress, couldn't gain terms with the top pair and was outfinished late for third. AUSTIN'S ACE disputed the pace racing four wide into the turn, drifted out midway through the bend and gave way. ORPHAN TINKA was switched off the inside, soon came under pressure but offered no response. URNOTDABOSSAME flashed brief pace between foes but gave way early. POWER ENOUGH, bumped at the start, raced a bit erratically in early stages and trailed throughout.
