Footnotes

J T KINGFISHER was rated in hand in the opening stages racing just off the inside to the backstretch, steadily drew into striking position on the far turn, swung out five deep entering upper stretch to challenge and just prevailed under firm handling. AFFIRMED ACTION angled inwards to track just off the first flight racing to the backstretch, came out to lodge a four wide bid entering upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage in late stages but couldn't fend off the winner. ESKIMO KISS joined the pace between foes in the opening stages, pressed the pace to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. TAPESTRY IN MOTION was hustled to the front from the outset, dueled for command along the inside to the far turn, then weakened in late stages. SMOKE BABY tracked just off the first along the inside for five furlongs, bid for command along the rail in upper stretch but lost his momentum when caught in tight quarters through the final furlong. POWERFUL PEPPER was settled just off the inside to the backstretch, angled out nearing upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. PINE SIREN tracked just off and outside the first flight to the backstretch, advanced on the backstretch to press the pace four deep racing to the far turn, then gave way nearing upper stretch. JUST A CUT ABOVE worked his way to the inside early and couldn't produce the needed closing bid. FEUDAL CAT was pulling a bit while joining the pace three deep racing to the backstretch, then steadily retreated on the far turn. DOGTOOTHKID trailed.
