Footnotes

LOWELL DEAN was allowed to settle in early stages, swung out gaining momentum on the far turn, was fanned five wide in upper stretch but produced a sustained late response to just edge MOONING YOU in the final strides. The latter raced unhurried in the opening stages, made steady progress to challenge four deep nearing the far turn, gained command leaving midstretch but couldn't fend off the winner. HEAP WAMPUM, pulling early, prompted the pace outside foes racing into the first bend, dueled outside a rival into the far turn, continued to resist to upper stretch when challenged but weakened in late stages. POWERFUL PEPPER was settled near the inside, angled out in upper stretch but had no final bid. PEACE SIGN dueled for command along the inside to the backstretch, then gave way on the far turn. PINE SIREN was a brief factor between foes but was spent after a half. JESTINTIME flashed brief pace but was spent early.
