C C TAT went up to force the pace outside a rival from the outset, went clear on the backstretch, then held sway to the end under steady prompting. DAWN RAIDER tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside for a half, came through inside the pacesetter to challenge in late stages but was always second best. SIR TRICKY was settled outside foes early, then made some mild progress to gain a share racing into the stretch. XEP FOR ELMER, forwardly placed in the opening quarter, relinquished the lead to a rival entering the backstretch, angled outside that foe to challenge nearing upper stretch but was unable to sustain that effort. CAPTAIN BUCKY tracked the leaders along the inside while unhurried early and never gained contention. HEY SLICK was allowed to settle and offered no rally. WILL E SCAT tracked the leaders racing three wide in the second flight but came up empty after a half.
