SATURDAY IN MAY was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to be clear under strong handling. DON'T BLUFF pressed the pace, gained command down the backstretch, raced three deep in the lane and finished second best. LITTLE WAGON was slow early, moved up five wide into the lane and showed good late interest. KEEP ME POSTED raced evenly and had no rally. ILIKECHOCOLATEMILK failed to respond. PACIFIC TSUNAMI showed good speed from the inside and gave way. BRAVO PRADO failed to sustain a bid. BIG BRUIN pressed the pace and tired. Big Bruin had to be vanned off. SLEW CITY STORM stalked the pace and tired readily.
