Late nomination fee: \$500 by June 1, 2007. \$300 to pass the entry box and \$300 additional to start. A supplementary nomination of \$3,000 may be made at the time of entry which includes entry and starting fees. With \$60,000 guaranteed (\$32,100 from Canterbury Park and \$12,500 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund with the balance to include nominations, entry and starting fees) of which \$36,000 to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. WEIGHT: 120 lbs. Maidens allowed 3 lbs. HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (WINNERS PREFERRED). (Non-starters least preferred). Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A portion of the nomination fees may be retained by the MTA for nomination expenses. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (S)

**Footnotes**

PALM READER, urged to secure a forward placing three deep between foes racing to the first bend, was held up nearing the backstretch to track the leaders from just out of striking position, advanced when called upon on the far turn racing three or four deep, came through close quarters four wide entering upper stretch to challenge, drew on terms with the pacesetter while drifting inwards a bit but prevailed under firm left handed encouragement. SUL LAGO, forwardly placed between foes racing just off the first flight to the backstretch, came out after a half to stalk just outside the leaders, advanced three deep on the far turn to challenge, took over nearing upper stretch, resisted the winner to late stages but came up second best. JAGAN, caught five deep between foes racing to the first turn, was taken in hand and angled inwards to track the leaders to the backstretch, switched out gaining momentum on the far turn, swung six wide in upper stretch to challenge and continued willingly to the end for a share. BANKER'S D LIGHT, caught five wide racing to the backstretch, tracked just off and outside the leaders to the far turn, advanced to challenge four deep on the second bend but flattened out in the drive.

GOTASHOTOFGOLD raced unhurried saving ground in the opening half, made a brief bid on the rail leaving the far turn but couldn't produce the needed final response. DOCTOR CLICK stalked just off the first flight to the backstretch, bid for command along the rail entering the far turn but quickly emptied out. HUNTER'S MONARCH was taken in hand soon after the break, tracked the pace between foes to the far turn but lacked the needed closing response. ABIT O IRISH was held up between foes near the inside in the opening stages and never gained contention. PLUM WILD AGAIN, off a step slowly, was caught wide racing into the first bend and soon dropped out. SUDDENLY SILVER hopped at the start, stalked just off the first flight racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes on the second bend but steadily faded from contention in the drive. GHAZI'S BIG EASY went up from the break to attend a rival's pace along the inside in the opening half, dueled for command racing into the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. BORN RUNNING was sent hard outside foes forcing the pace racing to the first turn and was used up after a half.
