### Footnotes

LOVE LOVE LOVE set the pace inside, turned back a challenge through the turn, got clear between calls, then lasted in a game effort. MARINA NOLAN mid pack and on the rail, gained position through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, closed well through the lane and hung. VALARI tracked the pace off the rail, moved up and angled out to bid four wide into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. TRUST N YOU stalked the pace three wide, bid on that path into the stretch and ran evenly. CURRENT TOPIC void of speed and inside, improved her position. DOC OF THE BAY was no factor. CLEVER THOUGHT vied for the early lead outside and was through after a half.
