GHOST SKIER stalked the early pace outside, moved up to bid just outside that one, then made a steady gain in the lane and edged ahead in the final strides under brisk handling. TRAFFIC SKIER set the pace off the rail, shook clear into the stretch between calls, then was outfinished. SPECTACULAR DEMI well placed and between rivals, moved up through the turn and bid between into the stretch, lugged in through the lane under strong left hand urging and held the show while no threat to the top two. LUCKY STRAW tracked the pace on the inside, came through inside into the stretch, checked at the furlong marker, altered out for clear racing room and held a share. CASINO CHARLEY well placed and three wide, came four wide to bid, drifted in in the lane and weakened in the drive. TIMBER HILLS showed little. THREE DESPERADOES pinched back at the start, was no factor. PIOUS PETE was never involved. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND A JOCKEY'S OBJECTION INTO THE RUNNING OF THE RACE, RESULTED IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF SPECTACULAR DEMI TO FOURTH
