Footnotes

FORENER never far back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, bid widest into the stretch and closed fast to edged ahead in the final strides. TIMETOBOOK stalked the early pace three wide, challenged for and gained a short lead through the turn, then was outfinished. TAKE A SHOT IN OZ vied between rivals for the early lead, dueled through the lane with PATRIATE and edged ahead of that one for the show. PATRIATE set the early pace inside, stayed on to duel with TAKE A SHORT IN OZ and weakened late. HAJA BOY tracked the early pace inside and ran evenly in the stretch. MACK'S MONARCH passed tiring rivals. THE BOOT tracked the early pace outside and had no rally. BORAZI was no factor.
