Footnotes

STARLET SKY broke sharply, dictated the pace inside foes to the backstretch, shook clear in upper stretch, and widened under a drive. VERZENE was steadied a bit in traffic early, tracked between foes to the far turn, swung five wide entering upper stretch and continued well enough to be up for second. BE MY FRIEND was allowed to settle outside a foe in the opening half, angled inside on the far turn gaining momentum, came through to challenge in midstretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was outfinished for second. QUAKER CHANGE, caught four wide in early stages, pressed the pace three wide into the far turn and flattened out. FOOL'S MATE, forwardly placed between foes, pressed the pace to the far turn and gave way. DANCE MATTIC was reserved along the inside but couldn't mount a closing bid. FARRAR was never a factor.
