### Footnotes

BAJA BOY was held up just off the first flight racing three deep to the bend, advanced in that path on the turn to challenge nearing upper stretch, took over in the final stages and pulled clear under firm handling. BIG RAH ducked inwards at the start, was righted quickly to duel for command between foes to upper stretch, couldn't match the winner but proved best of the others. CHARLIE TUNA was hustled to contend inside foes from the break, dueled for command into upper stretch, couldn't match the top pair and weakened in late stages. RED SHOES bobbled at the start, was collected to track just off the first flight along the inside and continued evenly through the lane. CASE IN POINT raced unhurried tracking the leaders, swung out five wide in upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. CART'S ROBIN, caught in tight quarters at the start, altered course to the outside just after the start and never gained contention. MOEKA hit the gate at the start, quickly recovered to briefly dispute the pace outside foes racing to the turn but gave way early. BISQUITS N GRAVY broke slowly, was settled near the inside and never gained contention.
