HIGHFLYERTOTHELINE set the pace inside, shook clear in the stretch, then drew off while being kept to the task. MISCHIEF LANE vied for the early lead outside, bid just outside the pace setter, could not go with that one into the lane, stayed on and held the place safe. MAGICAL STORM tracked the pace on the inside, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, then flattened out. NORTHERN BUDDY mid pack and inside, gained a striking position through the turn, then ran evenly in the lane. DIAMOND RAIN ran evenly. MANLEE SPIRIT passed tiring rivals. CAMPUS FLYER tracked the early pace from between rivals and steadily faded. GREAT IDEA was no factor. DANCER DEE well placed and three wide, faded after a half.
