MISS UPTOWN was hustled up the rail to dispute the pace inside a rival, pressed the issue racing into the far turn, edged away to a clear advantage leaving the furlong grounds, drifted inwards momentarily impeding a rival in the last sixteenth but prevailed under stout handling. S TABLE DANCER broke sharply, stalked just off the leaders into the backstretch under rating, came inside the pacesetter to challenge nearing the three sixteenths marker, continued willingly but was forced inwards a bit and steadied off MISS UPTOWN in the final stages. ORPHAN TINKA, unhurried tracking the leaders in the opening half, swung out nearing upper stretch and made a belated effort to improve her position. SWEET NIJINSKY tracked the leaders outside a rival as part of the second flight, advanced three wide to challenge midway through the far turn but flattened out in the drive. ANGELANO was rated off the pace to the backstretch and couldn't produce the needed late response. CHROMENALL was reserved from the break, angled to the inside on the first turn but never gained contention. DANYELL LEE was hustled to the front to join a rival on the pace, prompted that foe racing into the far turn but gave way in the drive. LACY ROSE was extremely rank prior to loading in the starting gate and was finished early. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AND DISQUALIFIED MISS UPTOWN FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HER SECOND.
