GO GO JILL vied for the lead in the opening quarter, took command by a slight margin in the backstretch, opened up slightly at the top of the lane and remained clear to the wire. FLEET DYNA settled in behind the early pace in early stages, saved ground along the inside coming into the stretch, could not catch the winner, held on to place in final strides. VERTICAL LIFT saved ground along the rail and stalked the early pace, raced three wide in the stretch and outnodded rival for show position at the wire. GLEE (GB) stalked the early pace, raced two wide coming into the stretch and failed to kick on in the late drive. IT'S TAMARENO saved ground racing near the inside and failed to be a threat late. WINE THIEF raced up close between rivals in early stages and had nothing left for the drive. TALKIN BOUT raced evenly and failed to menace. DIAMOND DISCO vied for the early lead and ,gave way after a half.
