EXTRA EXCLUSIVE took up a tracking position between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, angled to the rail nearing the bend while commencing a steady advance, came through when presented an opening nearing upper stretch to take charge, then went clear under firm hand urging and widened his advantage while being shown the whip. PINECREST INN, allowed to settle well off the pace in early stages, gathered momentum leaving the midway point of the turn, switched out to split foes nearing midstretch and continued that effort to secure second late. FIREONTHEWIRE tracked just inside the pacesetter in the opening quarter, angled outside that foe nearing upper stretch to bid between rivals, couldn't match the winner's bid, then lost second in the final stages. CHICKSTER sprinted to the lead while angling over, dictated the pace to upper stretch while drifting out a bit, then weakened once headed by the winner. SECRET FEVER angled inwards after the start to track just off the leaders between foes while unhurried, dropped off those foes on the bend but made an effort to improve his position in the lane. COOL LOVER exchanged bumps with BLAKE RATTLENROLL at the start, recovered to make some mild progress near the inside on the bend but had no final response. CAPTAIN MALORY was reserved outside foes early and never gained striking distance. BLAKE RATTLENROLL exchanged bumps at the start, was hustled along to chase the pacesetter into the turn, was carried out a bit after a half and quickly gave way.
