Footnotes

DESIGNED TO RUN close up and on the inside, raced boxed while moving up on the two path, was blocked into the stretch, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, angled back into the rail into the stretch, was blocked late, altered out and drove clear in the final strides. HOODWINKED HOLLY well placed and inside, gained position on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid and gain a short lead into the stretch, then drifted in and dueled with SAPPHIRE SUE and was outfinished while edging up for the place. SAPPHIRE SUE vied for the early lead outside, bid just outside the pace setter into the stretch, gained a short lead the last furlong, dueled with HOODWINKED HOOLY and weakened late. SILENT COPY well back and outside, was blocked through the second turn, angled out to avoid a fallen rival, then bid three wide into the stretch, altered out late for clear racing room and got up for a share. DOUBLE THAT HOPE well placed and outside, dropped back through the second turn, came again through the lane to pass tiring rivals. DEVILMADEMEDOIT void of speed, circled the field through the second turn, came widest into the stretch and flattened out. EGYPTIAN CHEER well back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid four wide into the stretch and faded in the drive. TIGER'S VICTORY set the pace inside and faltered. TEN THOUSAND LAKES lost contact with the field and eased over the wire. DEAR HRISHI clipped heels through the second turn and fell.
