JUST ONE SPOT broke sharply, sped clear of the field, held sway along the inside to the lane and widened his advantage under pressure. PLUM WILD AGAIN stumbled badly, then bumped MAGIC MILER at the start, was quickly righted to make a steady advance three wide racing through the bend and was just up for second. BORN RUNNING broke in, bumped NORTH WREATH, was collected to chase the pacesetter from between foes, proved no match for that rival in the drive and just missed second. POLISHED BRITELY tracked the pacesetter four wide racing to the bend and made an effort to improve his position late. O. G. HUNTER tracked the leaders along the inside and made some mild progress into the lane. SAMISLEW broke in, bumped JUST A CUT ABOVE, was righted to chase the pacesetter along the inside to the turn and emptied out. NORTH WREATH, bumped at the start, steadily improved position splitting foes on the turn, then drifted wide into the lane while fading from contention. JUST A CUT ABOVE, bumped soundly at the start, lost position to the field after the start and passed only tiring rivals. BOLD BULLDOG never seriously menaced. MAGIC MILER, bumped soundly at the start, never menaced thereafter. CHUCKIE CON QUESO was under pressure while five wide in early stages and soon dropped out.
