STAKES John Bullit S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$45,000 guaranteed, of which \$27,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 116 lbs; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 at one mile or over in 2007 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2007, 5 lbs; \$12,000 in 2006-2007, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (On the scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2006-2007 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed July 26 with 40. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile and 1/16 on the main track.)

PROSPECTIVE KISS took up a tracking position racing outside a rival from just out of striking position racing to the backstretch, gained some momentum leaving the far turn, came inside the pacesetter to challenge leaving the furlong marker and went clear late under firm encouragement. ON SAFARI tracked the leaders inside a rival while unhurried in early stages, swung out four wide nearing upper stretch and made some progress late to secure second. HONOUR COLONY sprinted clear of the field from the break, held a commanding margin to upper stretch but faltered late. SIR SWERVALOT angled inwards to gain terms with the pacesetter in the opening furlong while under stout restraint, tracked that rival on a bit looser rein into the backstretch, couldn't gain terms with the leader despite some urging on the far turn and steadily faded. LITTLE WAGON, allowed to settle in early stages, never gained contention.
