Footnotes

MILL TIME, bumped by ARGIANNA at the start, was righted to track just off the pace racing to the backstretch, came out to challenge three deep entering the far turn, then edged away in the final stages under firm encouragement. DYNABELLE, unhurried in early stages, angled to the inside on the backstretch, steadily drew into contention on the second bend, awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, came through and continued evenly for the place. COUNTRY CHILD was allowed to settle along the inside racing to the backstretch, continued unhurried for five furlongs, was switched out five deep leaving the second bend and made a belated rally for a share. ARGIANNA broke out, bumped the winner, was urged along the rail to challenge for command racing to the backstretch, dueled into the far turn, then weakened once headed by the winner. GOLD BREAK IN was allowed to settle between foes in the opening stages and never gained striking distance. FATOULS GOLD was outpaced early. SPARKLING ENDEAVOR sped to the lead just off the inside, dueled outside a rival racing to the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. COSMIC WAVE flashed brief pace but was spent after a half.
