Footnotes

NOT SO FAST FESTUS set the pace on the inside, dueled through the stretch with CACHEMASSA CREEK and held under brisk handling. CACHEMASSA CREEK stalked the early pace three wide, angled in and bid between rivals into the stretch, then dueled with the winner through the lane and missed. THIRD RAIL well placed and outside, moved up four wide through the second turn, angled in slightly to bid three wide and gain a short lead, then weakened the final furlong. STITCHNTWINE tracked the pace inside while pulling, dropped back down the backstretch, then moved up three wide through the turn, bid four wide and flattened out. BANKER'S WAY improved his position. CAPTAIN DUDE was no factor. I'M THE GOLD vied for the early lead from between rivals and steadily faded after a half.
