**Footnotes**

LOST CAMPER sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, was never challenged, then drew off in the lane under steady pressure. SLEW CITY STORM never far back and off the rail, moved up down the backstretch, gained a striking position on the two path through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide, then made a steady gain to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. FIFTY TOO tracked the pace on the inside, gained position through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. DON'T BLUFF mid pack, moved up three wide down the backstretch, looped rivals on that path through the second turn to gain position, bid four wide into the stretch and ran evenly the final furlong. GRANDPA ROY improved his position. BRAVO PRADO well placed and outside, bid outside the pace setter, then faded the final furlong. HOOCHED EXPRESS fractious in the gate, was no factor. SOMMELIER SMARTY was never involved. FREE SAILING showed little.
