### Footnotes

BIG CITY BERNIE well placed and off the rail, moved up to bid three wide into the stretch, dueled with SWEETTALK'N JUNIOR, edged ahead of that one and drove clear late. TONY THE PONY well back and inside, angled out to loop rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain through the lane while no threat to the winner. SWEETTALK'N JUNIOR stalked the early pace outside pulling, bid outside the pace setter, dueled with the winner and weakened. FLEET CAVALRY void of speed, moved up on the two path through the second turn, angled out in the lane, came through traffic for a share. BIG STICK well placed and three wide, moved up on the two path through the second turn, angled out slightly to bid three wide, then ran evenly in the lane. SNARK well placed and inside, moved to position through the second turn and faded the final furlong. AZA mid pack and outside, moved up three wide through the second turn, then had no rally. MERLE T mid pack and inside had a mild gain. WALLY'S CHOICE had an inside trip and steadied late. SUBTLE HUNTER set the early pace inside and stopped.
